Superior Number Appeal

Bailiff: "It is the unanimous decision of the Jurats, with which I concur, having already refused leave to appeal, that the application for leave should be refused.

The Court is satisfied that the Inferior Number took into account everything which it should have taken into account. It did not misdirect itself and already allowed some mitigation more than the Crown was prepared to concede, by reducing the conclusions by six months.
