BEFORE: The Deputy Bailiff and Jurats Picot and Myles.

DEPUTY BAILIFF: Violence of this kind on the streets of St. Helier will not be tolerated by the Court. McGinn left his vehicle with the spear on two occasions whether he used it on the younger boy or not and the Court does not accept the explanation that he wanted to protect himself against the crowd. There was no provocation whatsoever, against McGinn personally. He assaulted a 16 year old victim and he has a serious record despite the gap. The Court therefore finds that the conclusions are perfectly reasonable and grants the conclusions. McGinn you are sentenced on count 1 to 12 months' imprisonment; on count 2 to 9 months' imprisonment concurrent; on count 3 to 3 months' imprisonment concurrent, making in total 1 years' imprisonment.
