Deputy Bailiff's reasons for Court's refusal to allow
to make "cession générale."

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The Court is of the opinion - and the Court is unanimous that Mr. M is unworthy of the privilege of "cession." The Court does not accept that he is a person of good faith and the application is refused. However, having regard to the reality of the situation and to the fact that he has been imprisoned for about 4 weeks for the present judgments, the Court is going to order his release from prison immediately. That will give him an opportunity to prove his good faith by at least paying current maintenance for his children and if he comes back seeking release from future imprisonment for new debts, he will find the Court much less sympathetic.
