DEPUTY BAILIFF: We consider this appeal is wholly without merit. The appellant lives at Trinity Hill, so he was, presumably on the way home, and we think that he knew exactly what he was doing; he was persistant, because having failed at the Chalet, he then turned his attention to the hotel proper. We regard 3 months imprisonment as absolutely the minimum sentence for breaking by night and it could well have been more, and we did in fact consider increasing it. A heavy fine has not deterred this appellant in the past. The appeal is dismissed and Mr. Cushen will have his legal aid costs.
