Your Counsel has said everything that could possibly have been said in your favour, but the Court agrees with the Attorney General that this was a vicious and cowardly attack with a dangerous weapon and but for the grace of God you could have caused very much more serious injury than you did cause, although there was in fact a fractured skull.

The Court has looked at all of the several cases, both in Thomas and the Jersey case of Nozedar, and the Court feels that these cases only support the conclusions requested by the Attorney General, and in the circumstances the Court has no hesitation in granting the conclusions of 4 yrs. imprisonment.
