COMMISSIONER DOREY: The facts alleged ... or the main facts alleged in the Order of Justice and in the Representation have been admitted by the defendant. And the explanation given by the defendant for her behaviour has not been accepted by the Court. Therefore, the Court confirms the Order of Justice as regards paragraph one of the Prayer thereof. That is the confirmation of the Injunction. Paragraphs two and three of the Prayer, that is the Prayer for costs and damages are to be left over to some later date to see whether or not the defendant accepts the position and abides by the Order of the Court. And the Court gives the defendant a very stern warning to abide strictly by the Injunction and not commit any further breach of the Injunction. She is not to do anything by hammering or knocking, or cause ... or playing music at an unnecessarily loud volume and at unreasonable hours, or in any other way to cause nuisance to the plaintiffs.

As regards the Representation, the fact for which, the breach of which is admitted by the defendant, the Court warns her that although no action is being taken by that breach, further breaches will be treated as an extremely serious matter. And the Court directs that the copy of the transcripts and the copy of the pleadings be sent to the Attorney General for his information.
