**The Waiting Restrictions (Newry) (2011 Order) (Amendment)
Order (Northern Ireland) 2011**

Made - - - - - *17th October 2011*

Coming into operation - *8th November 2011*

The Department for Regional Development(a) makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 4(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation (Northern Ireland) Order 1997(b) and now vested in it(c).

The Department has consulted such persons as it considered appropriate in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 2 of Schedule 1 to that Order.

The Department has published a Notice in compliance with paragraphs 1 and 3 of that Schedule.

No written objection or other representation has been received.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as The Waiting Restrictions (Newry) (2011 Order) (Amendment) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011 and shall come into operation on 8th November 2011.

Amendment

2. The Waiting Restrictions (Newry) Order (Northern Ireland) 2011(d) shall be amended by the addition to the Schedule of the following item —

“3. Glen Hill (north side) – from a point 15 metres west of its junction with the A2 Dublin Road for a distance of 70 metres in a westerly direction.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits vehicles waiting on the length of road specified in Article 2. Vehicles are excepted from the prohibition in certain circumstances.

A penalty charge (£60) is payable with respect to a vehicle involved in a contravention of the Order in accordance with the Traffic Management (Northern Ireland) Order 2005 and The Penalty Charges (Prescribed Amounts) Regulations (Northern Ireland) 2006.

Traffic signs indicating the effect of the Order will in due course be placed on the road.
