**The Sydenham By-Pass, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2025**

*Made* - - - - - *22nd January 2025*

*Coming into operation-* *26th February 2025*

The Department for Infrastructure<sup>(a)</sup> makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by Article 68(1), (3) and (5) of the Roads (Northern Ireland) Order 1993<sup>(b)</sup> and now vested in it<sup>(c)</sup>.

The Department in accordance with Article 68(4) of that Order is of the opinion that the lengths of the road described in the Schedule are not necessary for road traffic.

Notice has been published, served and displayed in compliance with paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 of Schedule 8 to that Order.

Four objections were received. Three objections were subsequently withdrawn, and one objection was duly considered.

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Sydenham By-Pass, Belfast (Stopping-Up) Order (Northern Ireland) 2025 and shall come into operation on 26th February 2025.

**Application**

2.—(1) The lengths of road described in the Schedule shall be stopped-up to all traffic at the lines specified therein.

(2) The Department shall carry out such works as it considers necessary to prevent or restrict to such extent as the Department thinks fit, access to the lengths of road described in the Schedule by all traffic.

3.—(1) All existing cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus placed along, across, over or under the road shall be retained.

(2) All existing rights as to the use or maintenance of such cables, wires, mains, pipes or other apparatus shall be preserved.

## SCHEDULE

Article 2(1)

### LENGTHS OF ROAD TO BE STOPPED UP TO ALL TRAFFIC

1. Sydenham By-Pass, Belfast (north-west side of the city bound carriageway) at a line opposite the pedestrian entrance to Sydenham Railway Station and adjacent to Sydenham Footbridge for a distance of 57.5 metres in a south-westerly direction, more particularly delineated and shown by the line marked A-B on Map No. IN1/24/606410.
2. Sydenham By-Pass, Belfast (south-east side of the country bound carriageway) at a line opposite the south-western entrance of the turning pocket leading to Belfast Yacht Club (south-west of Sydenham Footbridge) for a distance of 10.5 metres in a north-easterly direction, more particularly delineated and shown by the line marked C-D on Map No. IN1/24/606410.

A copy of the map has been deposited at the Department's Headquarters, 3rd Floor-Area A, James House, Gasworks Site, 2-4 Cromac Avenue, Belfast and at DfI Roads Eastern Division, 1st Floor, Hydebank House, 4a Hospital Road, Ballydoughan, Belfast.
