ROAD TRAFFIC

The A9 Trunk Road (Bankfoot) (Temporary Prohibition of
Specified Turns) Order 2010

Made

10th November 2010

Coming into force

18th November 2010

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1), and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of that Schedule because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A9 Trunk Road (Bankfoot) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2010, comes into force on 18th November 2010 and ceases to have effect at 0001 hours on 20th November 2010.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. No person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order to make any turn specified in Part 2 of that Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002^(b).

Direction of Police Constable

3. Nothing in this Order applies to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

Exemption for emergency and works vehicles

4. Nothing in this Order applies to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for the carrying out of the works in relation to which this Order has been made.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

That length of the M9/A9 Edinburgh – Stirling – Thurso Trunk Road from a point 1 kilometre or thereby south of the junction with the A9 Bankfoot/Stewart Tower Road to its junction with the A9/A923 Dunkeld, a distance of 13.15 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

All left turns into and out of the A9 Bankfoot/Stewart Tower Road.
