The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 1(4) of Schedule 12 to the Local Government Finance Act 1992⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with paragraph 2(2) of that Schedule they have consulted with such associations of local authorities as appear to them to be appropriate.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government Finance (Scotland) Amendment Order 2011 and comes into force on the day after the day on which it is approved by a resolution of the Scottish Parliament.

Amendment of the Local Government Finance (Scotland) Order 2011

2. For Schedule 1 (revenue support grant and distribution of non-domestic rate income 2011-2012) to the Local Government Finance (Scotland) Order 2011⁽²⁾, substitute the Schedule 1 set out in the Schedule to this Order.
