**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A1 Trunk Road (Spott Roundabout – Unnamed Road at Innerwick Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2011**

*Coming into force*

*21st September 2011*  
*1st October 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2) and 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule should be prohibited from making any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that there is an alternative route suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Spott Roundabout – Unnamed Road at Innerwick Junction) (Temporary Prohibition of Specified Turns) Order 2011, comes into force on 1st October 2011 and ceases to have effect at midnight on 1st January 2012.

**Prohibition of use of vehicles**

2. Subject to articles 3 and 4, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule so as to make any turn specified in Part 2 of the Schedule when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of that length of road by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 612 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

**Permission or direction of Police Constable**

3. No provisions of this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or upon the direction of a police constable in uniform.

**Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

4. No provisions of this Order shall apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

Article 2

SCHEDULE

PART 1

That length of the A1 Edinburgh - Berwick Upon Tweed Trunk Road being the northbound and southbound carriageways from Spott Roundabout to the Unnamed Road at Innerwick Junction, a distance of 4 kilometres or thereby.

PART 2

- (i) All right turns to and from the A1087 Broxburn Junction;
- (ii) All right turns to and from the unclassified road which leads to Little Pinkerton and is situated 170 metres south of the A1087 Broxburn Junction on the northbound carriageway;
- (iii) All right turns to and from the field access situated directly opposite the A1087 Broxburn Junction.
