ROAD TRAFFIC

The A92 Trunk Road (Leuchars) (Temporary 30mph Speed Restriction) Order 2012

Made - - - - 3rd September 2012

Coming into force - - 15th September 2012

The Scottish Ministers make the following order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1), 4(1) and 14(1)(b) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) ("the Act") and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(b) of the Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be restricted because of the likelihood of danger to the public which is not attributable to works that are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of the Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A92 Trunk Road (Leuchars) (Temporary 30mph Speed Restriction) Order 2012, comes into force on 15th September 2012 and ceases to have effect on 16th September 2012.

Temporary speed restriction

2. No person may use, or permit the use of any vehicle on the length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, specified in the Schedule at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour when a restriction is identified as applying to that length, or to a part or parts of that length of road, by means of a traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 670 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

Exemptions

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

Article 2

That length of the A92/A972 Kirkcaldy – Dundee Trunk Road from a point 2 kilometres or thereby south of the junction with the A913 at Parbroath Crossroads to a point 2 kilometres or thereby north of the said junction with the A913, a distance of 4 kilometres or thereby.
