ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A96 Trunk Road (Church Road, Keith) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *2nd November 2012*

Coming into force - - *11th November 2012*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2(1) and 2 and 4(1) and 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 16A(2) of that Act, they are satisfied that traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order should be prohibited for the purpose of facilitating the holding of a relevant event, being the Keith Armistice Day Parade, 2012, and enabling members of the public to watch that event.

In accordance with section 16A(3) of that Act, they are satisfied that it is not reasonably practicable for that event to be held otherwise than on that length of road.

In accordance with section 16A(8) of that Act, they have had regard to the safety and convenience of alternative routes suitable for the traffic which will be affected by this Order.

Citation, commencement and cessation

1. This Order may be cited as the A96 Trunk Road (Church Road, Keith) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012, comes into force on 11th November 2012 and ceases to have effect on 12th November 2012.

Prohibition of use of vehicles

2. No person shall use or permit the use of any vehicle on the length of road, or a part or parts of a length of road, specified in the Schedule to this Order when such prohibition is identified as applying to that length of road, or a part or parts of that length of road, by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 7010.1 and 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The Scottish Ministers are the traffic authority by virtue of section 121A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (inserted by the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 Schedule 8, paragraph 70 and amended by S.I. 2001/1400) as read with section 151(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 (c.54). The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemption

3. This Order does not apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire service, coastguard, ambulance, police purposes or a vehicle being used in connection with the placing of the required signage.

SCHEDULE 1

Article 2

That length of the A96 Aberdeen – Inverness Trunk Road known as Church Road, Keith from its junction with Banff Road, Keith to its junction with Seafield Avenue, Keith, a distance of 200 metres or thereby.
