1. This Order may be cited as the Scottish Civil Justice Council and Criminal Legal Assistance Act 2013 (Commencement No. 2) Amendment Order 2013 and comes into force on 10th October 2013.

Amendment of Commencement No.2 Order

2. In the Scottish Civil Justice Council and Criminal Legal Assistance Act 2013 (Commencement No. 2) Order 2013(2), in article 2 omit “20 (contributions for criminal legal aid)”.
