**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A725 Trunk Road (Bellshill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2016**

*Made* - - - - *23rd May 2016*

*Coming into force* - - *8th June 2016*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 62(1) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984<sup>(a)</sup> and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 62(1) of that Act, they are of the opinion that considerations of public safety and convenience require that traffic should be temporarily prohibited on the length of road specified in Part 1 of the Schedule while filming on the road takes place.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the A725 Trunk Road (Bellshill) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2016, comes into force on 8th June 2016 and ceases to have effect on 10th June 2016.

**Prohibition on use of vehicles**

2. No person may use, or permit the use of, any vehicle on the lengths of road, or a part or parts of the lengths of road, specified in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order when a prohibition is identified as applying to those lengths of road, or a part or parts of those lengths of road, by means of the traffic sign prescribed in Diagram 7105 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>(b)</sup>.

**Exemptions**

3. No prohibition imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) a vehicle being used in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance, police or coastguard purposes;
- (b) a vehicle being used in connection with the filming on the road; or
- (c) a vehicle being used in connection with the placing of the required signage.

4. The alternative routes to be used by traffic when the prohibition referred to in article 2 is operational are specified in Part 2 of the Schedule.

# SCHEDULE

## PART 1

Article 2

### SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

1. That length of the A725/A726 Shawhead – East Kilbride – Phillipshill Roundabout Trunk Road being the southbound carriageway from the off slip road for the B7070 Bellshill North Road to the off slip road signed for the B7071 to East Kilbride, Hamilton and the M74 to Glasgow, Carlisle, a distance of 2.58 kilometres or thereby.

2. That length of the A725/A726 Shawhead – East Kilbride – Phillipshill Roundabout Trunk Road being the northbound carriageway from the off slip road for the B7070 Bellshill North Road to the A725 where it meets the James Street Roundabout exit signed for The Strathclyde Business Park, Coatbridge A725, a distance of 2.58 kilometres or thereby.

## PART 2

Article 4

### ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

3. Those lengths of road being the B7070 Bellshill Road and Hamilton Road, the A775 Gartcosh Walk and the unclassified roads Belgrave Street and James Street.
