**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A82 Trunk Road (Tarbet to Inverarnan) (50mph Speed  
Limit) Order 2017**

*Made* - - - - 26th October 2017

*Coming into force* - - 9th November 2017

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make this Order and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the A82 Trunk Road (Tarbet to Inverarnan) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 2017 and comes into force on 9th November 2017.

**Speed restriction**

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

**Exemption**

3. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(d) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations; or

## SCHEDULE

Article 2

### SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A82 Dalnottar - Inverness Trunk Road from a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 232367, 704828) at Taret, 397 metres or thereby east of the extended centreline of its junction with Still Brae, northerly, to a point (at Ordnance Map coordinates 231920, 719432) 250 metres or thereby south of the extended centreline of the access to Glen Falloch farm, near Inverarnan, a distance of 17.067 kilometres or thereby.
