The Health Protection (Coronavirus) (International Travel) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2020

The Scottish Ministers make the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by section 94(1)(b)(i) of the Public Health etc. (Scotland) Act 2008⁽¹⁾ and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 122(6) of that Act, the Scottish Ministers consider that these regulations need to be made urgently, without a draft having been laid before, and approved by resolution of, the Scottish Parliament.

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) These Regulations may be cited as the Health Protection (Coronavirus) (International Travel) (Scotland) Amendment Regulations 2020.

(2) These Regulations come into force immediately after they are made.

Amendment of the Health Protection (Coronavirus) (International Travel) (Scotland) Regulations 2020

2.—(1) The Health Protection (Coronavirus) (International Travel) (Scotland) Regulations 2020⁽²⁾ are amended in accordance with paragraph (2).

(2) In regulation 12(4) (fixed penalty notices – penalty amounts)—

(a) at the end of sub-paragraph (a) omit “ or”, and

“(b) regulation 9(2),

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations are made in response to the serious and imminent threat to public health which is posed by the incidence and spread of coronavirus in Scotland.

These Regulations make amendments to the Health Protection (Coronavirus) (International Travel) (Scotland) Regulations 2020. They amend regulation 12 relating to the penalty amounts of fixed penalty notices for offences under regulation 9 to clarify that regulations 9(3) and (4) are included.
