**The A830 Trunk Road (Glenfinnan) (40mph Speed Limit) Order
2020**

Made - - - - *14th July 2020*

Coming into force - - *21st July 2020*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 84(1)(a), and 124(1)(d) of, and paragraph 27 of schedule 9 of, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 84(2)(b) of that Act, they have given public notice of their intention to make the following Order, and have complied with Parts II and III of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 1987(c).

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A830 Trunk Road (Glenfinnan) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2020 and comes into force on 21 July 2020.

Speed restriction

2. No person may drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of road specified in the schedule.

Revocation

3. The A830 Trunk Road (Glenfinnan) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 1996(d) is revoked.

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

Exemption

4. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to—

- (a) vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011^(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations, or
- (b) vehicles being used in an emergency for coastguard purposes.

SCHEDULE

Article 2

SPECIFIED LENGTH OF ROAD

That length of the A830 Fort William to Mallaig Trunk Road from a point 584 metres or thereby south-east of the extended centreline of the U1191 Glenfinnan Pier Road (Slatach) in a north-west, west then north-west direction to a point 296 metres or thereby west of the extended centreline of the U5397 Torr An Eas, Glenfinnan Road, a distance of 1.999 kilometres or thereby.
