**NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL AND
REASONS FOR THE TRIBUNAL GIVING CONSENT**

1. The appellant has now been issued with a document confirming her right of permanent residence and now wishes to withdraw her appeal.
2. Consent of the Upper Tribunal is required for a party to withdraw its case. Having carefully considered the facts of this appeal as a whole, and observing that the appellant was unsuccessful in her appeal, I give such consent for the case to be withdrawn.
