## **JUDGMENT**

- 1. There was a relevant transfer of the Claimant to the Respondent pursuant to the Transfer of Undertakings (Protection of Employment) Regulations 2006.
- 2. The Claimant was unfairly dismissed by the Respondent and the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant a basic award of £8,622. No compensatory award is made in circumstances where the Claimant's employment would have been fairly terminated by the Respondent in any event by reason of redundancy after a period of consultation and the Claimant had continued in employment with Advanced Supply Chain (Logistics) Limited with a similar level of earnings and without any break in continuity of employment.
- 3. The Claimant's complaint of damages for breach of contract succeeds and the Respondent is ordered to pay to him as damages the sum of £44.
- 4. Pursuant to Rule 76(4) of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013, the Respondent is ordered to pay to the Claimant costs in the sum of £1,200 in respect of his Employment Tribunal issue and hearing fees.
