**JUDGMENT (Liability and Remedy)**

The claim of unlawful deduction of wages is well founded . I order £577.50 to be paid by the respondent to the claimant.

### **REASONS**

The claim of unlawful deduction of wages only, was presented on 28<sup>th</sup> December 2017. The relevant law is in section 13 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 .The name of the respondent was later amended and the claim re-sent A response was due by 8<sup>th</sup> March 2018 but none was received. I am required by rule 21 of the Employment Tribunals Rules of Procedure 2013 to decide on the available material whether a determination can be made and , if so I am obliged to issue a judgment which may determine liability and remedy. I consider the above judgment appropriate because I have sufficient information to enable me to find the claim proved and to determine the sums claimed in the claim form are accurate .
