JUDGMENT

1. The claimant's claim of unauthorised deduction of wages was well founded and succeeds.
2. The respondent is ordered to pay to the claimant the sum of £797.50 gross, comprising £697.50 for two week's unpaid wages, plus £100 for unpaid overtime.
