## **JUDGMENT**

The claim is struck out under rule 37 of the Rules contained in Schedule 1 of the Employment Tribunals (Constitution and Rules of Procedure) Regulations 2013 on the grounds that the claim has not been actively pursued in terms of rule 37(1)(d).

## **REASONS**

- 1. On 10 January 2023 the Tribunal asked the claimant to provide a schedule of loss for the outstanding claims of wages, holiday pay and breach of contract by 24 January 2023. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 2. On 03 February the Tribunal reminded the claimant to provide the information outstanding by 10 February 2023. No reply was received from the claimant.
- 3. On 22 February 2023 the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to give

written reasons by 08 March 2023 or to request a hearing in order to consider why the claim should not be struck out. No reply was received.

4. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason why such a judgment should not be made or to request a hearing. The Tribunal therefore strikes out the claim.
