DECISION BY CONSENT ORDER

- 1. By consent, the appeal is allowed. This decision replaces the one issued by the Information Commissioner's Office on 04 June 2020, reference FS50877727:
 - 1.1. On appeal, the London Borough of Croydon is not disputing the Commissioner's findings in respect of sections 10, 17 and 40(2) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
 - 1.2. The London Borough of Croydon, in this appeal, claimed the exemption under section 21(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000; this had not been claimed during the Commissioner's investigation.
 - 1.3. The Commissioner accepts that section 21(1) applied to the withheld information.
 - 1.4. Parties agree that the London Borough of Croydon is no longer required to disclose the remaining withheld information.
 - 1.5. The requester has been informed of the position which has now been agreed between the parties and has not sought to join as a party to the appeal proceedings or challenge the reliance on section 21(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000.
 - 1.6. The parties have asked that there be no order as to costs; that will be treated as a promise by each not to make any application under rule 10 of the Tribunal Procedure (First-tier Tribunal) (General Regulatory Chamber) Rules 2009.
