Judgment of the Lords of the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council on the Appeal of The Owners of the Steamship "Amboina" v. Maung Shwe I, from the Chief Court of Lower Burma, delivered the 11th June 1903.

THERE is no question of law in this case, and there are two concurrent findings of fact—which seem to be established by the evidence of the Captain of the "Amboina" himself—that he was not a duly qualified person, and that he was wholly incompetent.

Their Lordships will therefore humbly advise His Majesty that the Appeal ought to be dismissed. The Appellants must pay the costs of it.
