ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A30 Trunk Road (Treswithian Junction, Camborne, to
Loggans Moor Roundabout, Hayle) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - *10 August 2010*

Coming into force - - *14 August 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A30 Trunk Road (“the A30”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Camborne and Hayle in Cornwall should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A30 Trunk Road (Treswithian Junction, Camborne, to Loggans Moor Roundabout, Hayle) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 14 August 2010.

2. In this Order –

“the A30” means the A30 westbound from the tip of the nosing of the westbound exit slip road at the Treswithian Junction, Camborne, to the northeastern edge of the Loggans Moor Roundabout, Hayle;

“the works” mean resurfacing and anti-skid works;

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 16 August 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A30.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

(c) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works.
