ROAD TRAFFIC

**The M58 Motorway (A59 Switch Island) to Junction 3
Eastbound Carriageway and Junction 1 Eastbound Entry Slip
Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010**

Made - - - - 9 September 2010

Coming into force - - 26 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M58 Motorway and slip roads, is satisfied that traffic on a section of that motorway and on one of those slip roads in the Districts of Sefton in Merseyside and West Lancashire in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the M58 Motorway (A59 (Switch Island) to Junction 3 Eastbound Carriageway and Junction 1 Eastbound Entry Slip Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 26 September 2010.

2. In this Order;

“the motorway” means the M58 Motorway;

“works” means resurfacing and general maintenance works on the motorway;

“the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road” means the first point where the slip road joins the carriageway of the motorway;

“the works period” means four nights between 2200 hours and 0500 hours during a period starting on Monday 27 September 2010 and ending on Monday 25 October 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

“the length of motorway” means a section of the eastbound carriageway of the motorway from the start of the motorway at the point where it diverges from the A59 (Switch Island) to the tip of the nosing of the entry slip road at Junction 3;

“the slip road” means the entry slip road leading to the eastbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 1.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of motorway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
