ROAD TRAFFIC

The A14 Trunk Road (Junction 29, Bar Hill Interchange and Junction 26, Galley Hill Interchange, Cambridgeshire) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *18 October 2010*
Coming into force - - *25 October 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A14 Trunk Road (“the A14”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A14 Trunk Road (Junction 29, Bar Hill Interchange and Junction 26, Galley Hill Interchange, Cambridgeshire) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 25 October 2010.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall –

- (a) during a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 1 November 2010 or on any subsequent day until principal bridge inspection work to the overbridge at Bar Hill Interchange has been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A14 eastbound exit slip road leading to the B1050 at Junction 29, Bar Hill Interchange, or
- (b) during a period of 9 hours starting at 21.00 hours on Wednesday 3 November 2010 or on any subsequent day until principal bridge inspection work to the overbridge at Galley Hill Interchange has been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A14 eastbound entry slip road leading from the A1096/London Road at Junction 26, Galley Hill Interchange.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for, or in connection with, the said works or for winter service maintenance, police, fire and rescue authority, ambulance or traffic officer purposes.
