ROAD TRAFFIC

The A259 Trunk Road (Icklesham) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010

Made - - - - *18th October 2010*
Coming into force - - *6th November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A259 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A259 Trunk Road (Icklesham) (Temporary 10 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 6th November 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A259 Trunk Road at Icklesham in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 30 metres east of Manor Close and 110 metres east of Oast House Road;

“works” mean the construction of a traffic crossing;

“a first works period” means a period of 6 hours starting at 0930 hours on Monday 8th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 5th May 2012; and

“a second works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 8th November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 5th May 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5 below, no person shall, during a first works period or a second works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
