ROAD TRAFFIC

The A31 Trunk Road (Beech Lane, St Leonards) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *1st November 2010*
Coming into force - - *20th November 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A31 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A31 Trunk Road (Beech Lane, St Leonards) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 20th November 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A31 Trunk Road (Ringwood Road) in the County of Dorset;

“Beech Lane” means the road known as Beech Lane at its junction with the westbound carriageway of the trunk road at St Leonards;

“works” mean carriageway repairs and all associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 22nd November 2010 or on any subsequent day until 19th May 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter the trunk road from Beech Lane or to enter Beech Lane from the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding to or from premises accessible from, and only from, Beech Lane to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
