ROAD TRAFFIC

The M6 Motorway (Junctions 40 - 39, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - *18 November 2010*

Coming into force - - *5 December 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway is satisfied that traffic on that motorway, in the District of Eden, in the County of Cumbria should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway (Junctions 40 - 39, Southbound Carriageway) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 5 December 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the M6 Motorway;

“the length of carriageway” means a section of the southbound carriageway of the motorway from a point 175 metres north of the centre of Harrowsteads Railway Bridge to a point 100metres north of the centre of Trainrigg Bridge.

“works” means resurfacing works on the motorway;

“the works period” means a period starting at 2000 hours on Monday 6 December 2010 and ending at 0600 hours on Monday 13 December 2010. However, work may start and continue beyond these dates for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the length of carriageway.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance services or to anything done at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or traffic officer in uniform.
