**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Catholme, near Barton under Needwood,  
Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of  
Traffic) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - 22 November 2010

*Coming into force* - - 29 November 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road at Catholme, near Barton under Needwood in the County of Staffordshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(a)</sup> and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Catholme, near Barton under Needwood, Staffordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 29 November 2010.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A38 between a point 300 metres and a point 330 metres north of the centreline of Catholme Lane/Dogshead Lane overbridge;

“central reservation” means that part of the trunk road which separates its carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular traffic using that road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 2000 hours on Wednesday 1 December 2010 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway in the central reservation of the A38, 100 metres north of the centreline of Catholme Lane/ Dogshead Lane overbridge.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. The provisions of –

(a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; and

(b) article 4 shall not apply to –

- (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
- (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) personnel engaged in the said works.
