ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A36 Trunk Road (Wind Whistle Lane, Alderbury, Wiltshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *1st July 2011*
Coming into force - - *2nd July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Alderbury, in Wiltshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Wind Whistle Lane, Alderbury, Wiltshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2011.

2. In this Order –

"layby" means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b); and in this definition "carriageway" means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works” mean works to install cables;

“a works period” means a period of 6 hours starting at 09.30 hours on Tuesday 5th July 2011 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter, proceed or remain in the layby situated adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the A36, approximately 200 metres north of Wind Whistle Lane, near Alderbury, Wiltshire.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

(a) a vehicle being used for police, traffic officer, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes;

(b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or a traffic officer in uniform;

(c) a vehicle being used for or in connection with the said works.
