**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A36 Trunk Road (Norridge Common, Near Warminster)  
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *1st July 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *2nd July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A36 Trunk Road (“the A36”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road near Warminster in Wiltshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A36 Trunk Road (Norridge Common, Near Warminster) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the A36” means the A36 near Warminster from the western edge of its roundabout junction with the A350/B3414 to a point 1350 metres northwest of that roundabout junction;

“the works” mean works in relation to excavation and reinstatement for a new electricity supply to a weather station;

“the works period” means the period starting at 08.00 hours on Monday 4th July 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to an article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period:

- (a) drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the A36;
- (b) cause or permit any vehicle to overtake any other moving vehicle or make a U-turn on the A36.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to:

- (a) a vehicle being used for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes; or
- (b) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable.

5. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
