ROAD TRAFFIC

The A40 and A449 Trunk Roads (Over Ross Roundabout to Travellers Rest Roundabout, Herefordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - 23rd August 2011

Coming into force - - 30th August 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A40 Trunk Road (“the A40”) and the A449 Trunk Road (“the A449”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads near Ross on Wye in the District of the County of Herefordshire should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A40 and A449 Trunk Roads (Over Ross Roundabout to Travellers Rest Roundabout, Herefordshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 30th August 2011.

2. In this Order –

- “Over Ross Roundabout” means the A449/A40/B4234 roundabout junction;
- “Travellers Rest Roundabout” means the A449/B4221/M50 Junction 4 roundabout junction;
- “the trunk road” means –
- (i) the eastbound carriageway of the A40 from a point 100 metres west of its junction with Over Ross Roundabout to that roundabout, including the circulatory carriageway of that roundabout; and
 - (ii) the eastbound carriageway of the A449 from its junction with Over Ross Roundabout to its junction with Travellers Rest Roundabout;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Monday 5th September 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 10 miles per hour on lengths of the trunk road whilst traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on those lengths of road are displayed.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the eastbound carriageway of the A449 at its junction with the access road 150 metres east of its junction with Over Ross Roundabout.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of –

(a) articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;

(b) articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for Special Forces purposes; and

(c) article 5 shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works.
