ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A5 Trunk Road (Near Hinckley, Leicestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *24th January 2011*
Coming into force - - *31st January 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road near Hinckley in the County of Leicestershire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Near Hinckley, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 31 January 2011.

2. In this Order:

| “the roundabout” | means the A5/B4109/M69 Junction 1 roundabout; |
| “the trunk road” | means –
(i) the eastbound carriageway of the A5 from its junction with the roundabout for a distance of 100 metres; and
(ii) the westbound carriageway of the A5 from its junction with the roundabout for a distance of 100 metres; |
| “the works period” | means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 7 February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed, |

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
