ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A52 Trunk Road (Holme House Junction, Nottinghamshire)
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

Made - - - - *18th November 2011*
Coming into force - - *25th November 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport being the traffic authority for the A52 Trunk Road (“the A52”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road west of Radcliffe on Trent in the County of Nottinghamshire should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A52 Trunk Road (Holme House Junction, Nottinghamshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 25th November 2011.
2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 00.01 hours on Saturday 26th November 2011 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this Order, cause or permit any mechanically propelled vehicle to enter or leave the A52 at its junction with Sandy Lane, also known as Sanday’s Lane (Holme House Junction).
3. The provisions of article 2 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
