ROAD TRAFFIC

The A453 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 24 to Crusader Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - - *28th January 2011*

Coming into force - - - - - *4th February 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A453 Trunk Road (“the A453”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between M1 Junction 24 and Crusader Roundabout in the Counties of Leicestershire and Nottinghamshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A453 Trunk Road (M1 Junction 24 to Crusader Roundabout) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 4th February 2011.

2. In this Order –

“the trunk road” means the eastbound and westbound carriageways of the A453 from its roundabout junction with the M1 at Junction 24 to its roundabout junction with Barton Lane/Hartness Road/Clifton Lane (Crusader Roundabout);

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b); and in this definition “carriageway” means a way constituting or comprised in a trunk road (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a surface suitable for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 7 February 2011 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby adjacent to the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with Kegworth Road, north of Thrumpton.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
