**The Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans)
(Amendment No.3) Order 2011**

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971(a):

1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment No.3) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 26th March 2011.

2. In Part 1 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000(b), insert “Resolution 1973 (2011) of 17 March 2011 (Libya)” at the appropriate place.

3. In Part 2 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000 insert after “Council Decision 2011/137/CFSP of 28th February 2011 (Libya)”, “as implemented by Council Implementing Decision 2011/175/CFSP of 21 March 2011 (Libya)” (c).
