ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A49 Trunk Road (Hereford) (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) (No.2) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *14th May 2012*

Coming into force - - *21st May 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”) is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the City of Hereford should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Hereford) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) (No.2) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 21st May 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this order, no person shall, during the period starting at 09:30 hours on Thursday 24th May 2012 and ending when the said likelihood of danger has been avoided by means other than this order –

- i) drive any motor vehicle on the northbound and southbound carriageway of the A49 between its junction with Barton Road and its junction with the A4103 (Holmer road); or
- ii) cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave or enter any side road on the length of the A49 described in i) above.

3. The provisions of article 2 of this order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
