**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Alrewas to Barton Turn, Staffordshire)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - - *28th May 2012*  
*Coming into force* - - *4th June 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and two of those connecting roads between Alrewas and Barton Turn in the County of Staffordshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Alrewas to Barton Turn, Staffordshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 4th June 2012.

2. In this Order:

- “the trunk road” means –
- i) the northbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with slip road leading to the A513 at Alrewas to its junction with the slip road leading from the B5016 at Barton Turn; and
  - ii) the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the slip road leading to the B5016 at Barton Turn to its junction with the slip road leading from the A513 at Alrewas;
- “a slip road” means the slip road leading to the northbound carriageway of the A38 –
- i) from the A513 at Alrewas; and
  - ii) from the junction with Dogshead Lane at Catholme;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 11th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

**3.** Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or a slip road.

**4.** The provisions of articles 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (c) being used in connection with the said works.
