**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A38 Trunk Road (Toyota Interchange to Clay Mills)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

*Made* - - - -

*6th June 2012*

*Coming into force* - -

*13th June 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A38 Trunk Road (“the A38”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads, in the Counties of Derbyshire and Staffordshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A38 Trunk Road (Toyota Interchange to Clay Mills) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 13th June 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its junction with the exit slip road leading to its roundabout junction with the A50 (Toyota Interchange), to its junction with the slip road leading from the A5121 at Clay Mills;

“the slip road” means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A38 from its roundabout junction with the A50 (Toyota Interchange);

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 18th June 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works; or
- (iv) proceeding in the trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road.
