**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation
Display Teams) (No. 6) Regulations 2012**

Made - - - - *13th July 2012*

Coming into force - - - *14th July 2012*

The Secretary of State deems it necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Farnborough, Hampshire, by reason of the intended holding of flying display practice by the Royal Air Force Aerobatic Team, the Red Arrows on 14th July 2012.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 6) Regulations 2012 and come into force on 14th July 2012.

Interpretation

2. In regulation 3 all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time.

Restricted airspace

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) between 0700 hours and 0845 hours on 14th July 2012 no aircraft is to fly below 8,300 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 6 nautical miles whose centre is at 511639N 0004632W.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying within controlled airspace or within an aerodrome traffic zone in respect of which there is an appropriate air traffic control unit(b) if it flies in accordance with a clearance or permission of the unit controlling that airspace or zone.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations impose an additional restriction on flying at Farnborough, Hampshire, during a flying display practice by the Red Arrows on 14th July 2012.

This restriction is additional to that imposed at Farnborough on 14th July 2012 by the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 4) Regulations 2012 (S.I. No. 2012/1230).

Full details of the restricted airspace will be published by NOTAM.
