ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A5 Trunk Road (Churncote to Shottaton, Shropshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 19th November 2012

Coming into force - -26th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road between Churncote and Shottaton in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Churncote to Shottaton, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

- “the trunk road” means –
- i) the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the A458 (Churncote Roundabout) to its roundabout junction with the unclassified roads leading to Felton Butler and Nesscliffe (Felton Butler Roundabout; and
 - ii) the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 from its roundabout junction with the B4396 (Wolfshead Roundabout) to its junction with the B4397 at Shottaton;
- “the works period” means the period starting at 21:00 hours on Monday 3rd December 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed,

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
