ROAD TRAFFIC

The A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 16th November 2012

Coming into force - - 23rd November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A46 Trunk Road (“the A46”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road and on some of those connecting roads, at Wanlip in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A46 Trunk Road (Wanlip, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 23rd November 2012.

2. In this Order:

| “the trunk road” | means the southbound carriageway of the A46 from its roundabout junction with the A607 (Hobbyhorse Roundabout) to its junction with the slip road leading from the A6 (Wanlip Interchange); |
| “the slip road” | means the slip road leading to the southbound carriageway of the A46 from Wanlip Road; |
| “layby” | means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of |

way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 26th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road or the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to –

- (i) the southbound carriageway of the A46 172 metres south west of its junction with the exit slip road leading to Rectory Road; and
- (ii) the southbound carriageway of the A46 278 metres south west of its junction with the exit slip road leading to the M6 at Wanlip interchange;

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 6 and 7, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with the unnamed road 250 metres north east of Rectory Road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

7. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works.
