ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A21 Trunk Road (Flimwell)(Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour
Speed Restriction) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *10th December 2012*

Coming into force - - *29th December 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Flimwell) (Temporary 50 Miles Per Hour Speed Restriction) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 29th December 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex;

“the length of trunk road” means the trunk road between points 215 metres and 825 metres south of its junction with the A268 (Hawkhurst Road) and the B2087 (High Street) at Flimwell;

“works” mean footpath maintenance work on the trunk road; and

“the works period” means the period starting on Wednesday 2nd January 2013 and ending 28th June 2014.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the length of trunk road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(b) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
