The Lord Chancellor, after consulting the Lord Chief Justice, makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 92(6) of and Part 1 of Schedule 11 to the Children Act 1989(a).

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings (Amendment) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 2nd April 2012.

**Revocation of jurisdiction**

2. Dewsbury County Court, Ilford County Court and Keighley County Court shall cease to be family hearing centres.

**Amendments to the Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings Order 2008**

3. The Allocation and Transfer of Proceedings Order 2008(b) shall be amended by omitting the entries in Schedule 1 (classes of county court) to that Order relating to:

- (a) Dewsbury County Court;
- (b) Ilford County Court; and
- (c) Keighley County Court.
