The Lord Chancellor, with the concurrence of the Senior President of Tribunals, makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by paragraph 2(2) of Schedule 2 and paragraph 2(2) of Schedule 3 to the Tribunals, Courts and Enforcement Act 2007⁽¹⁾.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Qualifications for Appointment of Members to the First-tier Tribunal and Upper Tribunal (Amendment) Order 2013 and comes into force on 1st July 2013.

Amendment of the Qualifications for Appointment of Members to the First-tier Tribunal and Upper Tribunal Order 2008

2. The Qualifications for Appointment of Members to the First-tier Tribunal and Upper Tribunal Order 2008⁽²⁾ is amended as follows.

3. In article 2(4), at the end of sub-paragraph (n) insert a semi-colon and—

- “(o) in the drainage of land;
- (p) in farming and the ownership or management of agricultural property;
- (q) in relation to housing or housing conditions;
- (r) in matters relating to landlord and tenant relationships;
- (s) in valuation”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order amends the Qualifications for Appointment of Members to the First-tier Tribunal and Upper Tribunal Order 2008 ([S.I. 2008/2692](#)). It adds new grounds of eligibility for appointment as a member of the First-tier Tribunal or the Upper Tribunal who is not a judge.

In consequence of the transfer of agricultural land tribunals and rent assessment committees in areas in England as from 1st July 2013 by the Transfer of Tribunal Functions Order 2013 ([S.I. 2013/1036](#)) eligibility is extended to persons having substantial relevant experience in land drainage, farm management or ownership, housing or housing conditions, landlord and tenant relationships, or valuation.
