**The A5 and A43 Trunk Roads (Towcester, Northamptonshire)
(Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - 22nd April 2013

Coming into force - - 29th April 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”) and the A43 Trunk Road (“the A43”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of those roads, at Towcester in the County of Northamptonshire, should be restricted and prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 and A43 Trunk Roads (Towcester, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 29th April 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the first length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A43 between a point 2000 metres north of, and a point 2000 metres south of, the roundabout junction with the A5 and Towcester Road;

“the second length of trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 between the roundabout junction with the A43 and Towcester Road, and the junction with Brackley Road and Northampton Road;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a

length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“bus stop area” means any area of a carriageway on a side of the trunk road, intended for the waiting of buses, which is comprised within and indicated by a road marking complying with diagram 1025, 1025.1, 1025.3 or 1025.4 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(a);

“the footway” means the footway adjacent to the second length of trunk road;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 6th May 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the first length of trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the second length of trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby adjacent to -

- (i) the northbound carriageway of the A5 approximately 105 metres north of its junction with Brackley Road and Northampton Road;
- (ii) the northbound carriageway of the A5 approximately 25 metres north of its junction with Brackley Road and Northampton Road;
- (iii) the southbound carriageway of the A5 approximately 90 metres north of its junction with Brackley Road and Northampton Road;
- (iv) the southbound carriageway of the A5 approximately 35 metres north of its junction with Brackley Road and Northampton Road; and
- (v) the southbound carriageway of the A5 approximately 135 metres north of its junction with Brackley Road and Northampton Road.

6. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the second length of trunk road at its junction with –

- (i) Old Green Nortons Road;
- (ii) Old Tiffield Road; or
- (iii) Northgate.

7. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any bus stop area situated adjacent to the second length of trunk road.

8. Subject as mentioned in articles 9 and 10, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any pedestrian to enter or proceed in the footway.

9. The provisions of articles 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

10. The provisions of:

- (a) article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle being used for special forces purposes;
- (b) articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes; or
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- (c) articles 4, 5, 6 and 7 shall not apply to any vehicle –
 - (i) being used in connection with the said works;
 - (ii) proceeding in the second length of trunk road to or from premises which are accessible for that vehicle from, and only from, that road; and
- (d) article 8 shall not apply to –
 - (i) any pedestrian engaged in police, fire brigade or ambulance activities;
 - (ii) any pedestrian acting under the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) personnel engaged in the said works.
