**The A49 Trunk Road (Bromfield to Craven Arms, Shropshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - 5th June 2013

Coming into force - - 12th June 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A49 Trunk Road (“the A49”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Craven Arms and Bromfield in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A49 Trunk Road (Bromfield to Craven Arms, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 12th June 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A49 from its junction with the A4113 at Bromfield to its roundabout junction with the B4368 Corvedale Road at Craven Arms;

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a traffic sign of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the sign is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 21.30 hours on Wednesday 19th June 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated adjacent to the trunk road.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with any side road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle-

- (a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable in uniform; or
- (c) being used for or in connection with the said works.
